1. PENDING DRAFT REGULATIONS

At the time of writing this report (beginning of August 2013), the draft amendments to the Copyright Act presented to the Committee last year have not yet been adopted by the Thai parliament. Update (if any) will be provided during the APAA Council Meeting on October 20, 2013.

The pending draft provisions awaiting consideration of the Parliament are the following:

- the "Exemptions to Copyright Infringement for disabled people and Copyright offences relating to recording movies in theater" amendment to the Copyright Act aiming in particular to criminalize unauthorized camcording in cinemas has been already approved by the Council of State and endorsed by the Cabinet on January 21, 2013.
- The amendment to the Copyright Act to ensure better protection to works in digital forms, which has been finalized by the Council of State and secured endorsement by the Cabinet on October 9, 2012.

At time of writing this report (August 2013) these amendments have not yet been adopted.

2. MAJOR CASES

Customs seizures:

In January 2013,

• The Royal Thai Customs arrested 62 offenders and the pirated products had a value of 24,266,050 baht.

In February 2013,

 The Royal Thai Customs arrested 60 offenders and the pirated products were worth 10,944,473 baht.

In March 2013,

• The Royal Thai Customs raided 16,160 pirated products. The value of which was 6,752,304 baht.

Police raids:

The Royal Thai Police reported so far 339 copyright infringement cases and confiscated 63,049 exhibits.

The Department of Special Investigation (the "DSI") seized 1,070 pirated products for total of 5 cases.

In May 2013,


• The newly established National Intellectual Property Right Center of Enforcement (the "NICE") arrested 3 offenders and confiscated 14,555 pirated products (shoes, trousers, glasses, gloves mobile cases and other goods).


